


James Rizzi was an American artists who lived and painted in Brooklyn, New York



James Rizzi was known for his "happy city" paintings, which showed NYC as a happy, colorful city. His illustrations have made an impression on viewers of all ages. In this lesson, we will be creating 3D buildings using design elements that give the buildings personality!

- Use design elements to give buildings personality (ie, eyes, nose, mouth)






James Rizzi was most famous for his idea of "3D multiples". While in college, he had to turn in work for a printmaking, painting, and sculpting class. Because he was short on time, he decided to combine all these media into one piece- making an etching, hand painting it, and adding it to a canvas using wire to create sculptural depth.
