ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE SCHOOL, HIGH SCHOOL, MUSEUM, HIGHER EDUCATION, AND SUPERVISION/ADMINISTRATION DIVISION DIRECTOR GUIDELINES

It shall be the duty of the Division Directors: to serve on the Board of Directors; to promote membership in the FAEA; to disseminate important information to members in their division; to report the activities of the division to the membership in each publication of the FAEA Fresh Paint; to develop the program for their division level including conferences and other professional activities.

It shall be the duty of the Division Directors to:

1. Serve on the Board of Directors; attending all FAEA meetings and reporting on division initiatives.
2. Serve on committee(s).
3. Serve on the official Nominating Committee for new officers.
4. Plan the program for their Division meeting at the fall conference.
5. Disseminate important information to members in their Division through a monthly email and a column in Fresh Paint.
6. Interpret trends and investigate means for the continuous development of art education for the purpose of relating this information to the membership through conference presentations and through both FAEA and NAEA publications.
7. Broaden membership and interest in the Association among all art education professionals in their Division category.
8. Encourage members to use FAEA website.
9. Keep FAEA files with letters, lists of contacts, proposals, job descriptions, Fresh Paint and any of their division writings.
10. Act to encourage membership in FAEA.
